PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Hello members and friends,

The Gallery has had an eventful start to 2018. Local photographer Paul Reeve's, pop art on canvas exhibition titled '*Doodah-ism*' was our first exhibition for 2018. Paul's exhibition was very successful and his quirky style was enjoyed by many of the visitors travelling through our town over the holiday period. *Doodah-ism* was followed by '*Can You Remember*' from John Abery's Childhood Memories wood sculpture series. John's work certainly had an impact on visitors, especially the life sized teddy which was an amazing piece of craftsmanship. John's studio '*Wenlock*' is located in Hazelwood, South Gippsland and well worth a visit.

Currently we are showcasing a mixed media exhibition, '*Round Peg in a Square Hole*' by fourteen members from our local art group, Five Gates Studio. All work in this exhibition has been created on square canvases including a 16 piece group work, entitled '*Cezanne Revisited*'. We didn't hold an Opening Night for this exhibition, instead we will be holding an Exhibition Finale on Good Friday, prior to the opening of the Rotary Art Show. On the Saturday and Sunday of the Tarra Festival the Artists from Five Gates Studio will be available at the Gallery to discuss their work - 10am to 2pm - so why not pop into the Gallery and enjoy a chat with some of our local artists. The Tarra Tarras will also be performing at the Gallery on the Saturday morning of the Festival at 12pm – another reason to pop into the Gallery during the Tarra Festival.

After Easter our next exhibition will be '*Light Reading*' by Paul Savage. This exhibition will be the launch of Paul's first book, titled '*Rex, Oodles and Xenon Go Fishing*' – an all ages ABC book illustrated by Malcolm Drysdale who you many remember held an exhibition at the Gallery in 2017. Paul is a man of many talents, not only is an author, singer/songwriter and musician but he also crafts amazing lamps using plantation timber along with repurposed items. He has combined his lamps with the book launch, hence the name '*Light Reading*'. More information on this exhibition and book launch at a later date.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the volunteers who have been manning the Gallery from 3-4pm over the summer months and holiday period. Your support is invaluable and is very much appreciated. Thanks also must go to committee member, Stella Cormack who does a great job organising the volunteers' roster. We will be calling for volunteers again later in the year when once again we will open from 3-4pm, November to April. Perhaps you might like to help – something to think about.
